

**MINUTES OF A MEETING HELD AT OUP SPORTS CLUB,  
JORDAN HILL  
BETWEEN OUP AND SUMMERTOWN STARS, 26TH APRIL  
2007**

Present: For OUP Martin Humm (1st team manager) James Humm (1st team captain) Alan Parsons (football club secretary). For SSAFC Jim White (chairman)

OUP Football Club is very keen to re-establish links with Summertown Stars. James Humm played for the club while his dad Martin was a manager and vice-chairman for nearly ten years. Alan too was a parent. They are very sympathetic to our cause and would love to be regarded as the team of choice for any Summertown boys looking to play locally once they are too old for our club. It serves OUP's purpose too as they are anxious to improve the supply of new blood into their teams. In order to facilitate this, we have agreed on these measures, with implementation from next season:

1. All the players of SSAFC's u-16 and u-17 squads have been invited to attend OUPFC's pre-season training. This will take place from the end of July. James Humm will be in touch. Merv and Mark have been informed and are very keen to send as many of their players as can attend.
2. The better players will be invited by OUPFC management to turn out for the reserve team, which plays on a Saturday afternoon (thus not clashing with SSAFC games). There is a chance for some games with the first team too, for the better players. This will be a valuable intro to men's football for the boys. Though obviously this is entirely dependent on ability.
3. OUP will invite both the u-16 and u-17s to play a league fixture each on the OUP first eleven pitch. This will introduce the facilities to the boys and hopefully whet their appetites for joining OUP after graduating from SSAFC.
4. We will explore the possibility of naming the reserve team OUP Stars once the link between the two clubs is up and running.
